I also coach youth bowling at Starlight Lanes for the past 5 years on Saturday mornings. I put together a Mini Roller, adult/youth league on Monday nights in the summer. This year we have 17 teams and new faces.

2004-05 was asked to run for a board position and became a director on AWBA Board before they merged.

2006-14 was re-elected on CNM USBC Board and I continued as a director for several years before becoming 2nd vice president for 2 years and ran for 1st vice president won and served until family matters in Michigan made me retire. I headed the banquet committee and served on several other committees, such as Chair of Communications (4-8 page newsletters, (posters and invitations to banquet and open meeting during the year) also served on Hall of Fame, Nominating Committee and Legislative Committee.

Made raffle items and tickets for our Harley group in Albuquerque and money was donated to MDA. Donated items and held raffles for Breast Cancer and BVL. I organized a group to help with the Blue Star Mothers, sending packages to our servicemen and women.

I have served as Treasure for our Harley Owners Group; Volunteer and ran 4 State H.O.G. Rallies for New Mexico and volunteer my time for MDA.
