TOURNAMENT RULES

- All current USBC Youth members are eligible to enter.
- Junior Gold membership is not required to bowl in the tournament.
- Junior Gold entrants MUST be current Junior Gold members or purchase membership on site encouraged to purchase on BOWL.com.
- Tournament format shall consist of five games across a minimum of 10 lanes. All scores will be scratch.
- Bowlers will be assigned to the appropriate division based on the following:
 - **U18 Boys & Girls - birthdates between 8/1/07-7/31/09**
 - **U16 Boys & Girls - birthdates between 8/1/09-7/31/11**
 - **U14 Boys & Girls - birthdates between 8/1/11-7/31/13**
 - **U12 Boys & Girls - birthdates on or after 8/1/2013**
- At the tournament manager's discretion, Girls and Boys in the age division will be combined and contested without regard to gender or those bowlers will be moved to the next highest age bracket for competition. In the event of entry forfeit, tournament manager may re-assign the entry to a qualified bowler.
- Lane assignments will be assigned upon check-in at the event.
- All participants will bowl five games of qualifying with each participant moving to a new pair after each game. Standings after five games will decide who earns scholarships and Junior Gold Championships spots. A tie will be determined by a 9th and 10th frame roll off.
- One paid entry to the 2026 USBC Junior Gold Championships in Minneapolis, Min - July 11-18, 2026, for U12, U14, U16 & U18 will be awarded for at least one in every eight entries (at least 1:8), or major fraction thereof in a division. Entry will be paid directly to USBC by tournament management. The participant beyond the ratio (at least 1:8) will have the option of entering the Junior Gold by paying 1/2 of the Junior Gold entry. The tournament will pay the other half. Any excess fees collected will go to future Junior Gold Qualifier spots.
- Dress code:** Tournament management will determine if the uniform worn by the participant is acceptable. If the uniform is deemed unacceptable, the participant will be required to change immediately, or will be removed from competition.
Shirts - Competitors shall provide their own bowling shirt with a collared, V-neck, rib-lined or banded necklines. Mock collar must be a minimum of three-quarters of an inch. All shirts must have finished sleeves for all competition. Females may wear a sleeveless shirt with a butterfly collar only if the sleeves are finished.
Pants - Male participants are required to wear slacks. Slacks must not contain drawstring waists or elastic bottoms. Slacks must have a zipper and a button to be eligible. Jeans are not permitted.
 Female participants are required to wear slacks, skirts, capris, skorts, or walking shorts. All skirts, skorts, capris or walking shorts must be below the competitor's fingertips when they are standing and their arms are hanging loosely at their side. Jeans and yoga pants are not permitted.
Headgear - No covering or sunglasses can be worn while practicing or competing (hats, caps or bandanas, etc.) Male participants cannot wear any headgear while practicing or competing, unless a request is made in writing and approved prior to the event.
Electronic Devices - No electronic devices will be permitted during event other than score keeping applications.
- Only cash or credit cards will be accepted.
- Coaching during competition will be permitted, however the participant must meet their coach at the back of the bowler's area. Coaches and spectators are not permitted in the bowler's area.
- All other matters will be decided in accordance with USBC rules by the tournament manager. Decisions of the tournament manager will be final.
